

Hygiene concept event BAW

Event duration September 15-19, 2021

Status: 03.09.2021

General

1. Organizer is the education and action network Wandel e.V. (Siedlerweg 14 in 87437 Kempten).
2. The event will take place exclusively outdoors on the premises of the cooperative in the Heilstätte Harzgerode eG (Freie Feldlage 9, 06493 Harzgerode). Accommodation will be provided in tents brought by the participants.
3. Basis of this hygiene concept is the fourteenth SARS-CoV-2-Einindämmungsverordnung of the government of Saxony-Anhalt from 16.06.2021.
4. The number of participants is approx. 200 present including organizers. All persons will be registered and will receive a ribbon after registration. For the registration, the name, surname, address and telephone number will be kept for a period of four weeks after collection.
5. Persons with symptoms of Covid-19 according to the information of the Robert Koch Institute and persons with positive test results may not participate in the event. The most common symptoms are fever, cough, runny nose and disturbances of the sense of taste or smell.
6. Each participant must carry a medical mouth and nose covering and bring at least two self-tests to the event.
7. This hygiene concept will be communicated to all participants in advance and will be displayed on site during the event.

Rules of conduct

8. The recommendations of the Robert Koch Institute regarding hand hygiene as well as coughing and sneezing as well as cough and sneeze etiquette.
9. 1.5 meter distance rule applies on the premises. If the distance rule cannot be observed in the short term, for example when serving food or in workshop tents, a medical mouth and nose covering must be worn.
10. Workshop tents will be ventilated regularly.

Mandatory testing

11. All participants must have a negative corona test upon arrival at the event. This also applies to set-up prior to the event. For this purpose there are three possibilities:
 - PCR test certificate, not older than 48 hours,
 - PoC antigen test certificate (rapid test), not older than 24 hours,
 - Self-test (self-brought), performed under supervision on site.
12. If a positive self-test results during the event, this must be reported via the hotline for suspected cases of corona: 0391 6717799. Affected person may only stay on the event premises in a quarantine area that has been set up in advance for this case, or in his or her own tent until a negative test result of a PCR test is available. For this purpose, information is provided via the hotline for suspected corona cases. All guests will be informed.

13. For attending a workshop where the spacing rules as well as the wearing of a mouth-nose covering cannot be observed, a self-test under the supervision of the participation, a self-test must be carried out under the supervision of the workshop leader.
14. We recommend you to do a self-test shortly after going home.

Kitchen area

15. The preparation of food takes place in an area that is clearly demarcated and only be entered by members of the kitchen team.
16. Disinfection of hands must occur prior to entering the kitchen area.
17. There shall be no self-service but outdoor food service by the kitchen team wearing a medical mask.
18. Before serving food, participants must disinfect their hands.
19. Dishes are provided and own dishes are not allowed.
20. When washing dishes and cooking equipment, it is ensured that a temperature of at least 60°C is reached.

Cleaning schedule

21. Toilets, sinks, and objects with which participants come into direct contact, e.g., doors, doorknobs, countertops, are cleaned several times a daily and the cleaning is documented.
22. Working and protective materials are provided in sufficient quantity.
23. Sufficient hand washing facilities with liquid soap, disposable hand towels and hand sanitizer are provided.

Enforcement

24. Participation in the event is contingent upon endorsement of this concept. The Orga Team reserves the right, after consultation with the Awareness Team, exclude people from the event.
25. The successful implementation of this concept is based on a mindful and responsible interaction between all participants. Thank you for your support!
